1. Total investment is all investment at original cost, including land acquired after filing of application. Investments made in a year should be reflected in the subsequent year's market value.
2. Use appraisal values from CAD as available. For future years, use market value that the entity estimates will approximate the market value for ad valorem tax purposes in that year.
3. This amount is typically the taxable value for the purpose of I&S fund or debt service reserve fund.

The CPA requests companies complete the electronic spreadsheet version of the form and submit identical electronic and hard copy versions of the spreadsheet (with any attachments) to the district.
