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Additional Information and Calculations

The required qualifying job annual wage was calculated as follows:

- 1. Chapter 313.051 is applicable because Nolan and Taylor County meet the eligibility requirements of the statute. ¹
- 2. Pursuant to 313.051(b), a property owner is required to create only at least 10 new jobs on the owner's qualified property.²
- 3. Further, at least 80% of these jobs (8 total) must be qualifying jobs. A qualifying job must pay 110% of the average weekly wage for manufacturing jobs in the region.³
- 4. Nolan and Taylor County are in the West Central WDA.4
- 5. Pursuant to the most recent data compiled by the Texas Workforce Commission, the mean annual wage for all jobs in the manufacturing industry in the West Central WDA is \$35,916. 5
- 6. At the 110% rate required by 313.051(b), the required annual wage for a qualifying job is \$39,508.
- 7. Thus, Turkey Track Wind Energy, LLC is required to employ at least 8 people at an annual wage of at least \$39,508.
